Family Discussion Questions

In Acts 10:34, Peter says *"I now realize how true it is that God does not show favouritism but accepts [people] from every nation..."*.

1. What is favouritism? How might people think God shows favouritism? Does he?

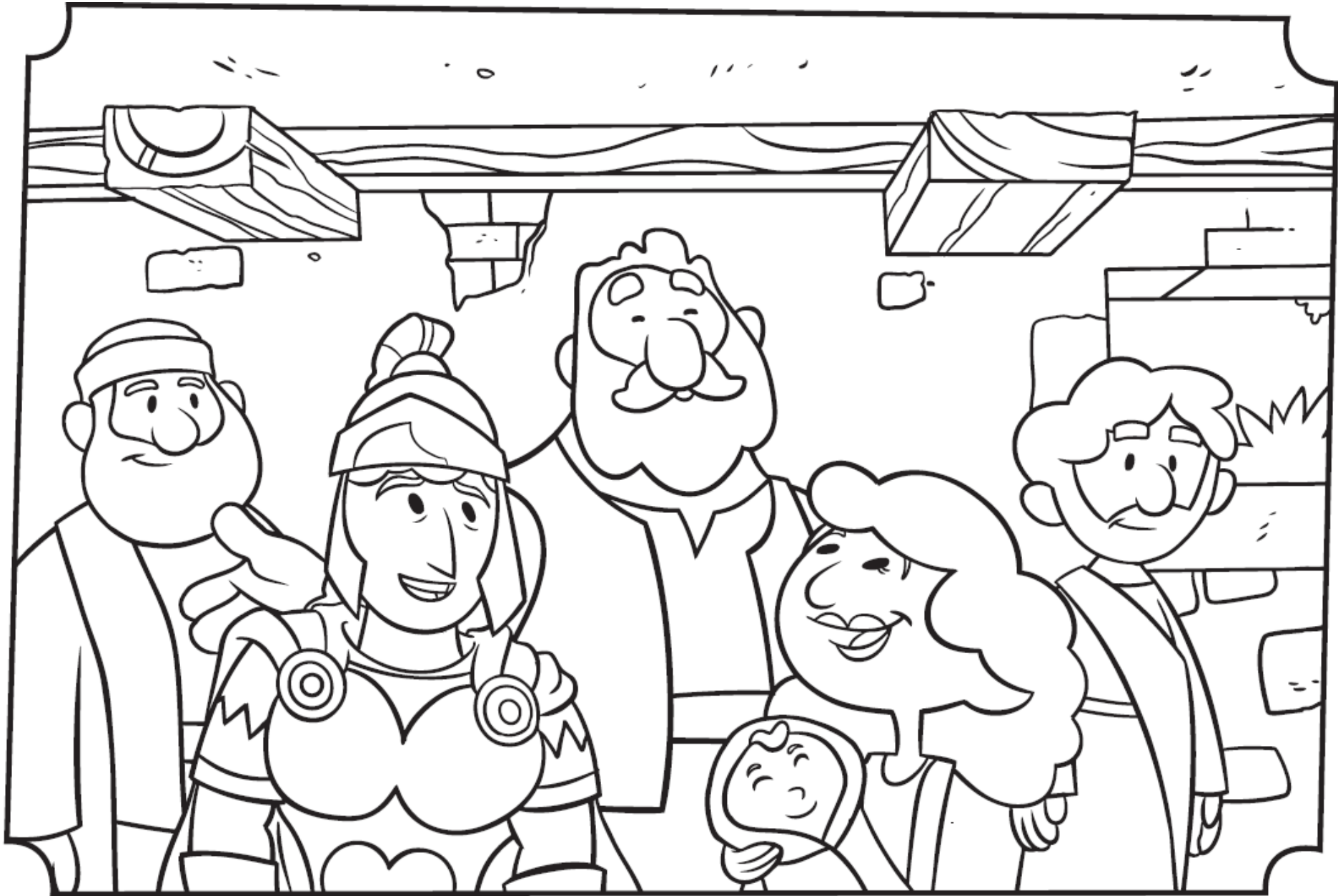
Peter shares Jesus with Cornelius
