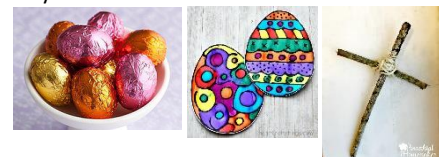
*Craft/Activity Ideas...

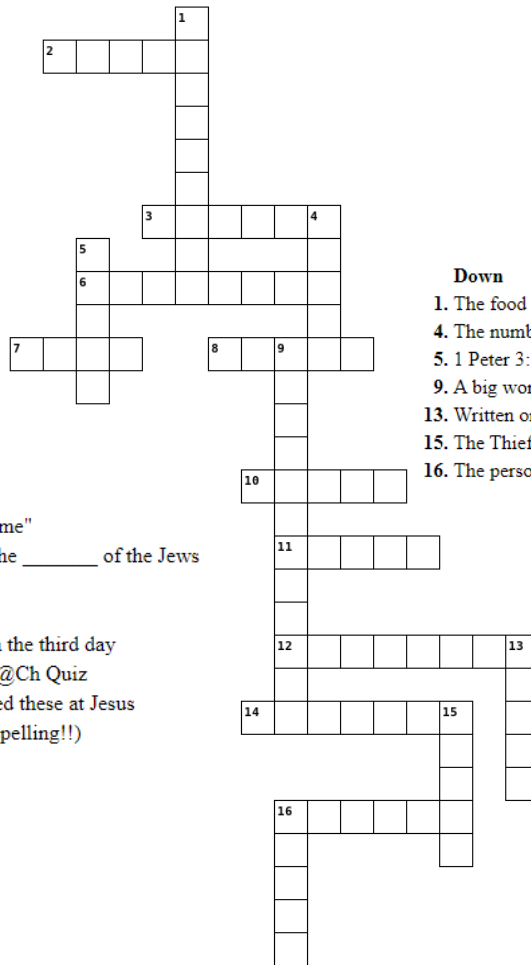

Family Discussion Questions

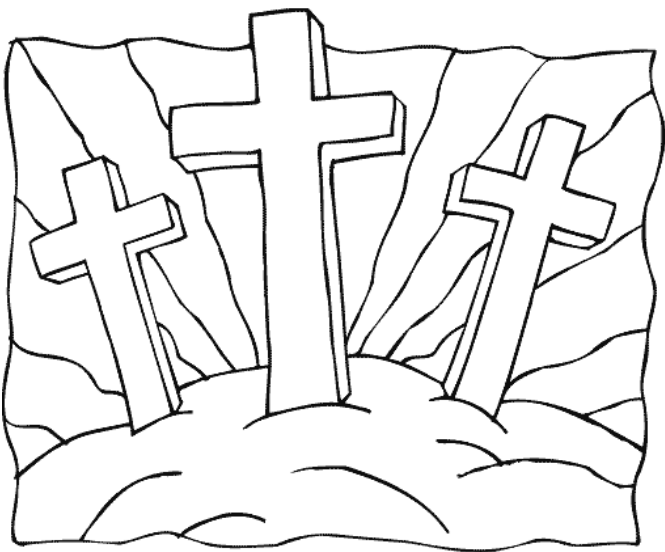
1. When Jesus died on the cross, was he dying because he had done **something wrong**?
2. Both of the thieves next to Jesus were also dying on crosses – but they were dying because they had done some bad things – like stealing, or killing. So **why did Jesus die on a cross for**?
3. One thief next to Jesus, knew that it was kinda fair enough that he himself was being punished, but he didn't think it was fair that Jesus was being killed for no wrong thing. So the thief who was a sinner, believed that Jesus was in fact the Saviour sent from God to save people... Like him! So very humbly, he asked for mercy – he said "Jesus, will you remember me". **How do you think the thief felt** when Jesus said "Yes, I will remember you, and take you to be with me in Heaven"? ☺

Jesus died for sins. But not his own – he didn't have any! He died for the thief's sins. He swapped places with him. Jesus also died for *your* sins. He's swapped places with you! Pray to God now, thanking him for Jesus and asking him quite simply to remember you!

4. Three days later Jesus rose from being dead. He's alive even today. He will come back, maybe soon, and we will enjoy the eternal life with him that he already has won for us at the cross, and the empty tomb. **What are you looking forward to about Heaven?** ☺
5. 1 Peter 3:18 says that Jesus died, the "righteous for the unrighteous" (that's the swap at the cross) "to bring you to God" (that's what the resurrection does. It gives us life with God... forever!) When we repent & believe like the thief in the bible story today, we are also saved by God. Tell me, is it your "good efforts" that *take you up* to God? Or does Jesus *come down to you*, do his work, and then bring you up to God?? ☺
