A) Understanding the Story (Daniel 2)

- King Neb was so mad, that he threw Daniel into the Lions Den
- King Neb basically says “Your God is the King of Kings” to Daniel
- In Jesus, God is building a kingdom that will last forever and will never be knocked down.



Can you fill in the blanks?

God gave King Neb a d_____, and it showed that his powerful kingdom would be overtaken by another king and his kingdom.
