A) Understanding the Story (Daniel 5)



Daniel 5: King Belshazzar did not humble himself BEFORE his coming judgment, will you?

Read aloud: In Psalm 90 verse 12, the Prayer to God says “Teach us to number our days”. There is an end to our lives. Some people don’t live like there’s an end. But at the end of everyone’s life we must face a good and holy and righteous God. The warning and encouragement from Daniel 5, and the writing on the wall to King Belshazzar, is to us, that we must humble ourselves now, before it’s too late! Because God is not just good and holy and righteous, he’s also merciful, gracious and shows loving kindness to those who ask. Jesus says “blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven”. When we humble ourselves before God, he blesses us in Jesus, and forgives us our sins, and gives us the gift of eternal life. Just like John 3:16 says – those who believe, shall not perish but have everlasting life. ☺
