Parent Prep beforehand →

1. Read through the below Message, Passage and Application for your own benefit.
2. Print out Activity Worksheet and fun activities in PDF
3. Prep any resources required including cut up Jigsaw.
4. Have a device and the video playlist ready for the kids to watch their lesson videos
5. Pray for your children to know and grow in following Jesus, for life!

Message: Jesus says: Do you love me? (Following Jesus requires a great love for him, because following him will come at a great cost!)

Passage: John 21:15-25 Jesus insists that Peter love him, as the job he gives him will lead to his death. The job seems to be Pastoring Jesus church – teaching and caring for the Shepherds sheep. The inclusion of lambs shows this work is ongoing, through the generations. When Peter sees John, he cannot help but wonder about his life and fate. So Jesus again corrects him to simply *follow me*, and not worry about what He might have for others. The cost of following Jesus of course is no different to the cost to Jesus himself, who was rejected, suffered and died - obedient even unto death, but was raised to life 3 days later. Note also Jesus here shows his gracious forgiveness to Peter – cf: Rooster crowing and Peters denial 3 times.

Application. There is a job to do – to make disciples of all nations – it will be hard. But because God loves us so much, we love him back despite the cost. The cost for us as kids in Canberra is our whole lives (living sacrifice / deny self take up cross and follow me / one died, therefore all died etc), but grounded might look like humiliation, segregation, missing out, persecution, hard work and effort – these will come as we deny ourselves so that we don't get polluted by the world (think resisting sin related to TickTok/Youtube/Instagram) as we grow in holiness, but also and maybe mostly as we speak about Jesus and are insulted, mistreated, and rejected by the government and our friends, and for some of us our families. The question is, in view of God's mercy, do you love Jesus? Even though there's a cost to following him? Yes? Then follow him, no matter what comes your way! 😊

Family Discussion Questions - @HOME

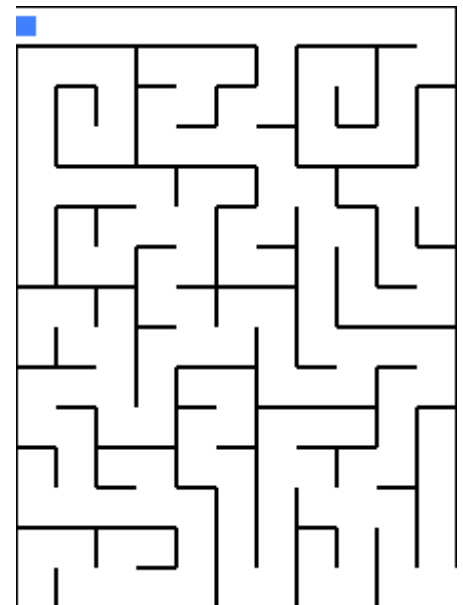
1. What's your favourite farm animal?
2. If we are like sheep, who is the Shepherd?
3. Like sheep Peter was a bit dumb – what did he do before the farmyard Rooster said “Cockadoodledoooo”?
4. Why do you think Jesus asked Peter 3 times if he loved him?
5. Did Jesus make Peter pay for his sin? What did Jesus do?
6. Wow! Jesus paid for Peter's sin, and showed him grace to forgive him, plus invite him and send him on a mission – Jesus' mission – what is this mission that Jesus sends all of his followers on?
7. Is making disciples easy or hard? What are some of the hard bits of following Jesus?
8. What would happen to Peter if he followed Jesus and did become a preacher and pastor of God's sheep?
9. Wow, following Jesus would lead Peter to his death! For us in Canberra, we also need to deny ourselves, take up our cross and follow Jesus, or, live for Jesus! – but we will only do it if we really love Jesus! Q: Do you love Jesus? Why? How much do you love him? Willing to live for him even if the cost is great?
10. Peter got a bit distracted by trying to compare his future with someone else's – John's. Does Jesus want you to compare yourself with others? How can you stop this? (You Follow Me)

Prayer: *Oh Great Shepherd, thank you for saving us dumb and sinful sheep and lambs. Thank you too for my Pastors who you have given to us to feed and care for us. Please help me also to follow King Jesus, denying myself, growing in holiness, and helping to make disciples of all nations. Help me not to compare myself with others, but to love you more and more, and follow you each day, Amen.*

Bonus Activities & Discussion

11. Look up and read Psalm 23 as a family, read the first line 3 times!!!
12. Write a “letter to God” telling him how much you love him! (That's like a Psalm!)
12. Often we say “Jesus loves you” But it's a good question “Do you love Jesus?” Challenge: Share with each other your top reason why you love Jesus
13. Look up and read 2 Corinthians 5:14-15. Note that this is the Mission verse of our church – Grippled by the love of Christ! Check out verse 17 too! Butterfly!!!!

Prayer: *Dear God, help me to know how much you love me, so that my love for you will increase! Help me to see the depth of my sin, and the heights of your grace. Then I will shout your praise to the ends of the earth! In Jesus saving name, Amen*

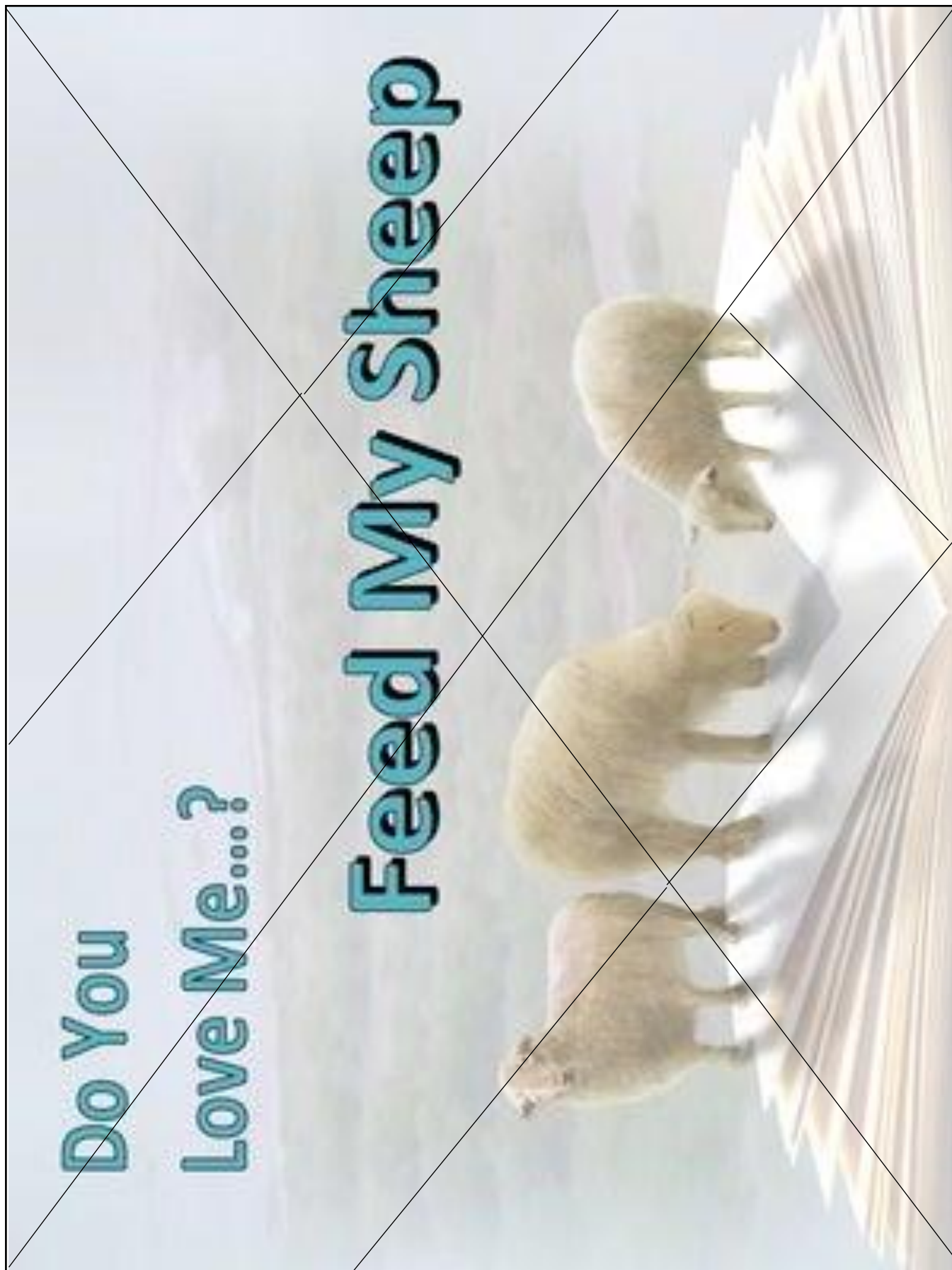

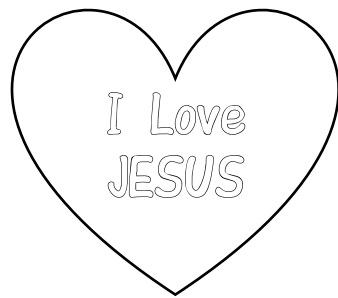
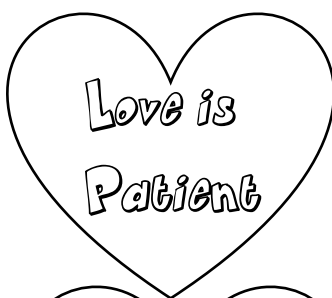
