What can we learn (some truths in the passage)?

- Jesus taught and healed showing he was Gods Promised Saving King
- Jesus himself claimed to be the Jewish Messiah when he said "This prophecy has been fulfilled today"
- His teaching was backed up by his healing with the same authority and power!
- Jesus uses his authority for good, not evil.
- Clearly came to teach – to proclaim the good news.
- Came also to do the work of freeing the prisoners, and setting oppressed free etc – cross.

Main Message to Teach:

- ✓ *Jesus, is not only qualified to be the promised saving king – he also demonstrated that he really is the one!*

Application / what to do in response:

- ✓ *Trust Jesus is God's Promised Saving King with all authority – so Listen and obey him.*





10. Did Jesus *only* come to proclaim the good news? What else did he come to do?


